RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. All Riders and exhibitors (in the open led classes) must be members of the Mt Barker Show Society.
- 2. There will not be any transferring of entries between any classes after submission of entry, except as described in clause 3 below.
- 3. In the case of a horse being measured prior to the Show, and a transfer being required, the current height certificate must be in the hands of the secretary or convenor by 5 pm on the evening before the show.
- 4. Any coaching during judging is strictly prohibited.
- 5. The protest fee for horse sections in CDSA shows will be \$100. Protests must be made in writing and be given to the Horse Convenor within 30 minutes of judging being completed.
- 6. Payment must accompany entry forms to validate the entry. Show secretaries will not take responsibility for cash sent through the post.
- 7. Refunds of entry fees only on receipt of a veterinary certificate naming the horse, or medical certificate naming the rider.
- 8. CDSA shows have an expectation that entrants will conduct themselves in a spirit of good sportsmanship and fair play at all times.
- 9. In the event of any inconsistencies between these rules and those of EA or any other association or club, these rules shall prevail.
- 10. If the forecast temperature is above 36°C (as advertised on the Channel 9 news at 6 pm on the night before the event),or the day declared a catastrophic fire day, the event will be cancelled.
- 11. In the case of the event being cancelled due to inclement weather, no refunds will be given.
- 12. Float/Truck parking is limited at Dunn Park Oval. Once entries are received to fill all available parks, entries will be closed. This may occur prior to advertised entry date closing. Please submit you entry early to avoid disappointment. **Late entries will not be accepted, please do not ask for exemptions.** No vehicle that is not attached to a Float will be admitted to float/truck parking area. If you have entered and then decided to not bring a float you are not entitled to parking in the float parking area. Spectator parking is available in the Mountain Pool car park. Mobility impared parking is available to the left of the caravan park entrance gate in signed area.
- 13. Random swabbing may take place at any time before, during or after this competition for exhibitors competing in the Open Royal Show Qualifying rings.
- 14. Medication Control of horses may take place in accordance with the Equestrian Australia Equine and Doping and Controlled Medication Regulations (1st edition effective 5th April 2010 and updates) and the Equestrian Australia Medication Control System and Swabbing Policy (1st January 2015).

SECTION REGULATIONS:

- $1.\ All\ riders$ who ride on the grounds must be members of Mt Barker Show Society and identified on the entry form.
- 2. In the interest of "Fair Play", once any horse has won first prize in two Royal Show qualifying events it is not permitted to compete in any further qualifying events.
- 3. Horses are to be shown as a Hack or Hunter, but not both.
- 4. Riders must wear approved helmet and riding boots whilst competing or warming up.
- 5. During judging, events will not be delayed for horses not in the ring when required. Late contestants will be scratched and no refunds given.
- 6. All ages of riders are taken on the day of the Horse Show.
- 7.Combinations competing in encouragement ring are only eligible to compete in Open Royal Show Qualifying rings in the following classes A124- A126 and A201, A230 A233. Horses can be ridden in the encouragement ring by a different rider, but rings will not be held.
- 7. The protest fee for horse sections in CDSA shows will be \$100. Protests must be made in writing and given to the convenor within 30 mins of judging being completed.
- 8. *Eligibility for class A230 exhibits must be registered with the Australian Thoroughbred Stud Book. A photocopy of Registration papers to be provided with entry form. Open to all competitors that have competed in 1 or more class on the day.
- 9. #Eligibility for class A231 exhibits must be registered as one of the following breeds Connemara, Dale, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh, Australian ponies, Fjord & Haflinger. A photocopy of Registration papers to be provided with entry form. Open to all competitors that have competed in 1 or more class on the day. Exhibits are able to be shown plaited or unplaited. Part-bred registered ponies are not eligible to compete in this class.
- 10. ^Eligibility for class A232 To be eligible, exhibits must be registered with the RPSBS. A photocopy of Registration papers to be provided with entry form. Open to all competitors that have completed in 1 or more class on the day. Over height Riding Ponies are not eligible to compete in this class.
- 11.**Eligibility for class A233 **This class caters solely for horses and ponies that are **15 years old or over**. They must be **home produced**, but can be any breed or type and must be in sound condition. Open to all competitors that have competed in 1 or more class on the day. **Home produced definition**: No pony/horse may have been stabled, schooled or competed from a professional show stable since 1st January 2017. Ponies/horse can only be shown by an amateur exhibitor who has not been involved with professional producing animals for the show ring since 1st January 2017. Riders must not have produced ponies/horses for financial gain since 1st January 2017. **Professional showing stable definition:** A person who produces/rides or handles ponies/horses for financial gain, including preparation, schooling for the show ring, or competes at a show for another exhibitor or owner.

- 1. All Owners & Riders must be members of the Mt Barker Show Society.

Competitors are responsible for knowing and complying with all EA rules. Making an entry for Interschool competitions constitutes implicit acceptance of the Rules by both the rider and their parent/guardian.

3.Interschool classes are conducted in accordance with the EA National Interschool Rules (effective 1 January 2017) and the relevant discipline National rules.

4.Riders taking part in the Event must be either members of the hosting club/event or junior or Interschool members of Equestrian South Australia (ESA), as per the entry requirements of the event.

5.Primary classes are restricted to riders enrolled up to and including year/grade 6 in the year of competition. Secondary classes is for those enrolled in year 7 to 12 inclusive in the year of competition, up to 18 years in the year of competition.

6.Riders competing at this event may qualify for selection onto the South Australian Interschool Team. Visit the Equestrian SA Website for a copy of the selection policy.

7. Riders must complete the registration for Interschool form prior to the event, and pay the relevant fee. Either \$40 for the season, or \$10 per event.

8. The school consent form must be completed with the registration form, or as soon as possible after registration.


