SECTION REGULATIONS: (Branched Broom Rape Weed Condition – page 15)

1. Exhibitors must be current financial members of Miniature Goats Australia Association Inc at time of entry.

Membership of Mt Barker Show Society is also compulsory.

2. All animals must hold current MGA registration certificates.

3. Animals must have an NLIS tag in place and identification will be confirmed prior to judging.

4. All Miniature Goats entered for competition must have been tested negative for CAE and Johnes Disease within 12 months of competition. Attach vet report and results to National Goat Health Statement when submitting your application

5. All Goats attending the Show must be accompanied by a completed "National Goat Health Statement" obtained at <http://www.farmbiosecurity.com.au/toolkit/declarations-and-statements/> The Statement must be completed in full and submitted with entry form/s. and show the Exhibitor's name, address, PIC and signature.

6. PIC numbers MUST be enclosed with entries.

Progeny and Breeders Section

29. **Sire OR Dam** and one progeny

Must be progeny of the same Sire OR Dam and animals must be owned by the same person/stud. More than one set of entries per Sire OR Dam may be entered in the same class. Judging is on improvement and refined characteristics passed down to kid/s from Sire OR Dam

30. **Breeders Pair**

Must be animals that have been bred by the same Stud, same stud name and same owner. Judging is on overall breed standards highlighting likeness, quality, conformation and consistency of being bred by the stud.

31. **2 Progeny from same sire or Dam**

Must be progeny of the same Sire OR Dam and animals must be owned by the same person/stud. More than one set of entries per Sire OR Dam may be entered in the same class. Judging is on refined characteristics and consistency of quality.

32. **Fancy Dress**

Animals can be selected from any of the above classes and are to be exhibited in fancy dress. Handler is also permitted to wear a costume if they choose to, but the MGA polo shirt must be worn at all times.
