3. If property is hard to locate, submit plan with entry form.

All results will be on display at the Mt Barker Pre-Show & Garden Presentation Dinner which is planned to be held in February 2021, depending on COVID 19 restrictions at the time.

The Judging Criteria is a 10 point system in the categories of Maintenance/Upkeep
Content and Appeal which add up to 30 points.

- 2 Front & Back Garden
- 3 Large or Rural Living Garden
- 4 Small or Restricted Garden (home unit, etc)
- 5 Most Colourful Garden
- 6 New Garden not previously Entered in competition
- 7 Productive Home Garden for home use or business use -- ie fruit & vegetables
- 8 Any other type of Garden ... (please state type on your entry form - landscaped, outdoor living area, special garden feature, cottage garden, spick & span etc.)
- 9 Business Presentation or Community Garden
- 10 Most Improved Garden, from 2019 competition.
