- R1103 Spinning; no restrictions, one skein 50 grams. Judged on creativity and novelty elements; Include samples of elements used.
- R1104 Weaving: Scarf, Shawl or wrap or any article/garment. Any hand-spun yarn, any fibre content, natural and/or dyed.
- R1105 Shawl or Wrap, crocheted or knitted, can be mixed colours, natural and/or dyed hand-spun fibre.
- R1106 Knitted Adult Garment using any natural or dyed hand-spun fibre.
- R1107 Knitted baby/child’s garment using any natural, hand-spun fibre; natural or dyed.
