2. Please Note: No exhibit to be removed before 4.30pm on Saturday of Show Day.
3. School and Children's name, age on show day & class number on back of exhibit.
4. An exhibit that in the opinion of the convenor has been entered in the incorrect Section/Class will be transferred to the correct Section/Class.
5. All reasonable care is taken of Exhibits; however no responsibility for loss or damage is accepted.
6. SCHOOLS NEED TO SUPPLY HELPERS TO REMOVE ENTRIES
7. Entries to be on a School's entry form - only 1 copy required
8. ALL SCHOOL GROUPS MUST ONLY ENTER THIS SECTION, NO SCHOOLS WILL BE ACCEPTED IN GENERAL ART SECTION V1-V2
9. In the case of work being of a similar theme/design work can be entered as a class project not as individual work (please specify on entry form).

13. No work larger than 1 m. square.

**HANGING GUIDELINES**

In order to avoid pin-hole or staple damage to art work while mounting the Section display, we ask that you follow the examples below.

- Either paper tabs on the works or mounted on paper for pins
- Heavy board or framed works must be supplied with hanging fixture or wire



Mount on paper that has sufficient edge for pins or accept that pins will leave holes in the art piece

Or- Tags to be placed on art
