### SECTION REGULATIONS:

1. Bottles for staging exhibits will be provided.
2. Marquee will be open between 5 & 8pm Friday night for the staging of exhibits. All exhibits to be staged by 9am Saturday and not to be removed before 4.30pm Saturday.
3. (a) All classes are N.N.D. (not necessarily distinct) unless otherwise stated in classes  
(b) DISTINCT; refers to varieties, not colour  
(c) A BLOOM; is one flower and little foliage on one stem  
(d) A CUT; is one stem with flowers and foliage and or buds  
(e) A SPIKE; is a single cut without side shoots  
(f) Exhibits to be staged and set firmly in bottles provided  
(g) One stem only; no laterals to go below neck of bottles  
(h) ROSES; full blooms, should have stamens showing  
(i) ROSES; NO ENTRY should exceed 18" or 45cm above neck of bottle.
4. GENERAL CUT FLOWER CLASSES (M201-M264) NOT TO INCLUDE ROSES OR DAHLIAS
5. THE ABOVE CONDITIONS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED
