RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. All Riders and handlers must be members of the Mt Barker Show Society. Led rider leaders do not need to be members.
- 2. There will not be any transferring of entries between any classes after submission of entry, except as described in clause 3 below.
- 3. In the case of a horse being measured prior to the Show, and a transfer being required, the current height certificate must be in the hands of the Convenor by 5 pm on the evening before the show.
- 4. Any coaching during judging is strictly prohibited.
- 5. The protest fee for horse sections in CDSA shows is \$100. Protests must be made in writing and be given to the Horse Convenor within 30 minutes of judging being completed.
- 6. Payment must accompany entry forms to validate the entry. The Convenor will not take responsibility for cash sent through the post.
- 7. Refunds of entry fees only on receipt of a veterinary certificate naming the horse, or medical certificate naming the rider. Refunds will be provided if show is cancelled due to SA Health guidelines in relation to Covid-19.
- 8. CDSA shows have an expectation that entrants will conduct themselves in a spirit of good sportsmanship and fair play at all times.
- 9. In the event of any inconsistencies between these rules and those of EA or any other association or club, these rules shall prevail.
- 10. If the forecast temperature is above 36°C as advertised on the Channel 9 news at 6 pm on the night before the event, or, the day is declared a catastrophic fire day, the event will be cancelled.
- 11. In the case of the event being cancelled due to inclement weather, no refunds will be given.
- 12. Please submit your entry early to avoid disappointment. **Late entries will not be accepted, please do not ask for exemptions.** No vehicle that is not attached to a Float will be admitted to float/truck parking area. If you have entered and then decided to not bring a float you are not entitled to parking in the float parking area. Spectator parking is available next to the clubrooms. Mobility impaired parking is available in the signed area behind the clubrooms.
- 13. Random swabbing may take place at any time before, during or after this competition for exhibitors competing in the Open Royal Show Qualifying rings.
- 14. Medication Control of horses may take place in accordance with the Equestrian Australia Equine and Doping and Controlled Medication Regulations (1^{st} edition effective 5^{th} April 2010 and updates) and the Equestrian Australia Medication Control System and Swabbing Policy (1^{st} January 2015).
- 15. No Horses are allowed on the sports fields past the competition rings. Please do not ride or lunge on the sports fields as marked.
- 16. PLEASE ENSURE THAT GROUNDS ARE LEFT AS YOU FOUND THEM AREA TO BE CLEAN OF MANURE/HAY AND HOLES FILLED IN, MANURE/HAY TO BE PLACED IN BAGS PROVIDED OR TAKEN WITH YOU. THANK YOU. Please note there will be a **refundable \$10 parking levy for each entry this year**. Once your horses are loaded on the float/truck, an attendant will inspect your area to provide you with a refund.
- 17. No stallions or colts are allowed on the grounds.

SECTIONS A1-A2 COUNT FOR 2023 CDSA POINTS

SECTION REGULATIONS:

- 1. All riders who ride on the grounds must be members of Mt Barker Show Society and identified on the entry form.
- 2. In the interest of "Fair Play", once any horse has won first prize in two Royal Show qualifying events it is not permitted to compete in any further qualifying events.
- 3. Horses are to be shown as a Hack or Hunter, but not both.
- 4. Riders must wear approved helmet and riding boots whilst competing or warming up.
- 5. During judging, events will not be delayed for horses not in the ring when required. Late contestants will be scratched and no refunds given.
- 6. All ages of riders are taken on the day of the Horse Show.
- 7.Combinations competing in encourage ring are only eligible to compete in Open Royal Show Qualifying rings in the following classes A124- A127, A201, A230 A233. Horses can be ridden in the encourage ring by a different rider, but rings will not be held.
- 7. The protest fee for horse sections in CDSA shows is \$100. Protests must be made in writing and given to the Convenor within 30 mins of judging being completed.

SECTION REGULATIONS:

- 1. All Owners & Riders must be members of the Mt Barker Show Society.
- 2. Riders may be led in all classes. Led riders must remain led all day.
- 3. All combinations competing in this ring are not eligible to compete in Open Royal Show Qualifying rings except in classes A201, A230, A231. Horses can be ridden by a different Rider in Royal Qualifying classes but rings will not be held.
- 4. Section A1-A2 riders are eligible to compete in the Fancy Dress.
- 5. Horses competing in these events are eligible to compete in any other class with another rider, but classes will not be held.
- 6. If led, horse must be in a snaffle bit, with lead line attached to a cavesson noseband or both sides of the bit.
- 7. All horses to be ridden in a snaffle bit. No double bridles allowed.
- 8. Classes may be spilt at the judge's discretion.
- 9. Riders must wear an approved helmet and riding boots in all classes (including fancy dress).


