N704 Parsnips, bunch of 4, tops on (Tied)

N705 Turnips, bunch of 4, tops on (Tied)

N706 Beetroot, bunch of 4, tops on (Tied)

N707 Spinach, Silverbeet or Chard, 6 leaves (Tied)

N708 Sweet corn, 3 cobs, leaves on

N709 Beans, 250gm

N710 Cucumbers, 3, any variety

N711 Zucchinis, 3, 200mm long approx.

N712 Zucchini, longest

N713 Pumpkin, butternut type

N714 Pumpkin, any other variety

N715 Pumpkin, any variety, largest

N716 Potatoes, any variety, 5 brushed

N717 Onions, plate of 5, unpeeled, neat roots

N718 Tomatoes, plate of 5, stems on

N719 Cherry or miniature tomatoes, punnet, stems on

N720 Rhubarb, 6 stems, tied, leave small part of leaves on

N721 Capsicums/Peppers, 3

N722 Lettuce, any variety, 1

N723 Cabbage, any variety, 1

N724 Parsley, bunch of 6 stems, tied (in water)

N725 Herbs, 1 variety, 20cm pot (or less)
