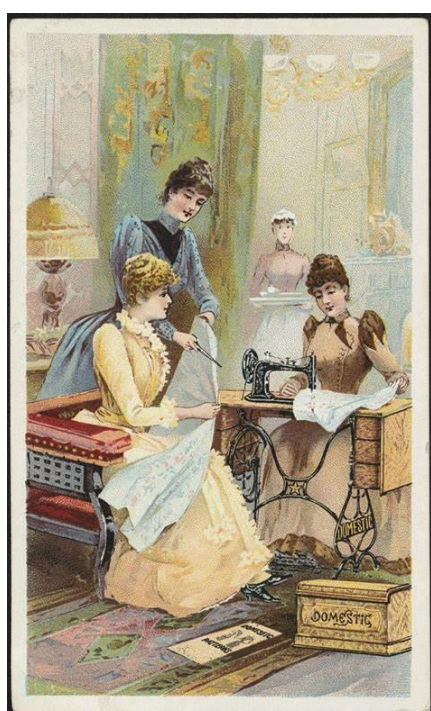

## **SECTION R11 – HANDSPINNING AND WEAVING**

### **CHAMPION RIBBON AWARDED**

- R1101 Spinning: 1 skein, 50 grams, hand-spun yarn from any natural or white fibre; include sample of unspun fibre.
- R1102 Spinning and Dyeing: 2 skeins, 50 grams each, from any natural fibre. Judged on spinning & dyeing ability and colour. Use a different type of dye for each skein, state dye type; include samples of unspun fibres used.
- R1103 Spinning; no restrictions, one skein 50 grams. Judged on creativity and novelty Elements; Include samples of elements used.
- R1104 Weaving: Scarf, Shawl or wrap or any article/garment. Any hand-spun yarn, any fibre content, natural and/or dyed.
- R1105 Shawl or Wrap, crocheted or knitted, can be mixed colours, natural and/or dyed hand-spun fibre.
- R1106 Knitted Adult Garment using any natural or dyed hand-spun fibre.
- R1107 Knitted baby/child's garment using any natural, hand-spun fibre; natural or dyed.
- R1008 Crochet Garment using any natural hand-spun fibre, natural or dyed
- R1109 Garment, using two or more techniques, knitted, crochet or woven, etc, mixed colours, natural or dyed, hand-spun fibre.
- R1110 Scarf, crochet or knitted, can be mixed colours, natural and/or dyed.
- R1111 Any small article, socks, toy, gloves, etc, any technique/s, natural or dyed, hand-spun fibre.
- R1112 Hat or Beanie. Knitted and/or crochet, natural and/or dyed, hand-spun fibre.
- R1113 Knee rug or blanket any technique, hand spun fibre/s dyed or natural colours.
- R1114 Any sculptured article from natural fibre.
- R1115 Any hand-felted garment, natural and/or dyed fibres.

## **HANDSPINNING - NOVICE SECTION**

These classes are open to exhibitors who have not previously won 1st, 2nd or 3rd places in the Mt Barker District Show and/or have only taken up the hobby of spinning in the last two years.

- R1122 Spinning, 1 skein 50gms hand-spun yarn from any natural or white fibre. (include a sample of unspun fibre.)
- R1123 Any garment using natural or dyed hand-spun fibre - any techniques.
- R1124 Scarf, Shawl or Wrap using natural and/or dyed hand-spun fibre - any technique/s.

## **SECTION R12 – ONE PERSON’S WORK**

### **CHAMPION RIBBON AWARDED**

**R1201 4 (four) articles, all of different handicrafts made by one person, any medium.  
But, all 4 articles have to be listed within the Handicraft Schedule Classes.**

The primary aim of this class is to showcase the diversity of skills of one exhibitor.

**The four items shall be FOUR DISTINCT techniques chosen from the Mt Barker Show Handicraft Section schedule. Each item is to be labelled with the class it would have been entered into individually.**
