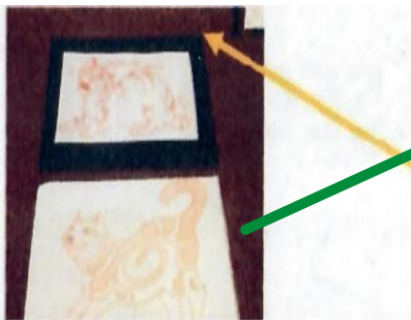

HANGING GUIDELINES

In order to avoid pin-hole or staple damage to art work while mounting the Section display, we ask that you follow the examples below.

- . Either paper tabs on the works or mounted on paper for pins
- . Heavy board or framed works must be supplied with hanging fixture or wire



Mount on paper that has sufficient edge for pins or accept that pins will leave holes in the
